• What activities does the LWSC offer?

The LWSC operates 3 venues with different activities offered at each one.

• Does the LWSC Ski Hill have chair lifts?

No, we're a pretty small mountain. We have a moving carpet (think moving sidewalk in the snow) that is great for beginners of all ages and two rope tows – one small and one that's pretty burly.

• How do I get tickets?

Buy them in person at the ticket booths located at each venue. We do not sell tickets online or ahead of time.

• Does the LWSC offer ski lessons?

Yes – we offer lessons in Alpine skiing & snowboarding at Ski Hill and Nordic skiing (both Classic and Skate technique) at the Icicle River Trails. Fill out a lesson request on our Lessons Page (skileavenworth.com/lessons).

• Does the LWSC rent any equipment?

The LWSC does not rent any equipment (tubing is all inclusive – you do not need to bring a tube). Please see the Equipment Rental page on our website (skileavenworth.com/equipment-rental). Sleds are available for purchase at the Golf Course.

• When is the LWSC open?

All of our activities are snow dependent. Check our Conditions Page (skileavenworth.com/conditions) to see what activities are available and our Hours Page (skileavenworth.com/hours) for specifics.

• Can I walk on your trails?

Nope. We maintain our trails for Nordic Skiing, Alpine Skiing, snowshoeing and fat biking. Footprints are not fun to ski over, and deep holes in the snowshoe trail caused by feet make for unsafe conditions for snowshoers and fat bikers. Want to take a walk? We recommend the Enchantment Park trail system that has easy access from downtown.

• Can I bring my dog to any of the facilities?

Dogs are not allowed at our 3 in-town facilities, except in the parking lots. But you can take them for a nice long walk at Enchantment Park or check out the Peshatin-Mill Site, just down the road in Peshastin.
